INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE FEMUR STUDY

A global prospective cohort study called Fracture-Evaluation-Management-Understanding-Research (FEMUR) aims to describe the operative & non-operative management of femur fractures in hospitals worldwide. The 28-day in-hospital data collection (between Feb-Jun. 2025) will identify in-hospital mortality, morbidity and mobility outcomes. If you are a national lead who has connections with hospitals that manage femur fractures, or a hospital lead who manages femur fractures, please consider participating. The findings will be published under the FEMUR Collaborative, with all contributors citable in PubMed.

ROS REPORTS BIGGEST POLICY BREAKTHROUGH FOR PEOPLE WITH OSTEOPOROSIS

Great news from the Royal Osteoporosis Society (ROS) which reports that bipartisan political support for universal FLS coverage has been secured for England and Wales. We warmly congratulate the ROS on the outstanding advocacy and awareness campaigns that contributed to this successful outcome. With universal access across the country, it is expected that some 74,000 fractures will be prevented over the following five years, including 31,000 broken hips – thus saving ca. 750,000 NHS bed days over the same period.
